

The Liberian culture is very rigid when it comes to the training of the young children to obey their elders in their community. They also love beer and wine - socially of course!! They have a passion for hosting strangers in their homes and share their culture with them, as they love to be at home.

- "Liberia" is a Latin word that translates to "Land of the Free". The country was founded by freed American slaves in 1821.
- Liberia is the first country in Africa to have a female president in 2006, Ellen Johnson Sirleah, who also won the Noble Peace Prize in 2011.
- The official language of Liberia is English but there are about 20 different ethnic languages spoken.
- The Liberian flag is modelled after the United States flag. Their capital city of Monrovia is one of only 2 cities names after a US president in the world.
- The population is made up of 16 different ethnic groups and tribes..
- The world's largest rubber plantation has been operating in Liberia since 1926 and is owned by Firestone, a subsidiary of Bridgestone Tires.
- Liberia is home to a large lush rainforest containing a rich variety of plants and flowers.

We would like to thank each and every employee for their hard work and commitment to the consumers and their well being. Your support makes it possible for our consumers to thrive and live their best life possible!





The free tax program (VITA-Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) offers families and individuals making less than \$65,000 free tax return preparation by trained and IRS-certified volunteers. Appointments are for federal and state tax preparation.

Free Tax Preparation Services

Tax Preparation services will be available at the below locations. Please make sure to bring your ID and social security cards/ITIN for each person listed on the return and documents listed below. We will not be able to prepare your return without these.

Important notices

- For the safety of guests, volunteers and employees a face mask is required upon entering all tax site locations. Thank you in advance for adhering to this policy.
- Due to the availability of volunteers returns may be scanned for virtual preparation.
 Additionally, availability will be limited and tax filing is not guaranteed.

Employee Relief Fund

Arc Mercer recognizes that life can take unexpected turns that we are not always be prepared for. We would like to extend the offer to help our fellow co-workers that may be struggling through a difficult time.

Arc Mercer has established an Employee Relief Fund, funded through voluntary payroll deductions made by Arc Mercer employees with Employer matched funds. This fund provides economic assistance to employees that have encountered a significant event in their life that has caused them hardship. The fund will be overseen by a Committee that will review applications for assistance.
